

# DRC Bid Round 2022 – Lake Tanganyika

#### LOCATION

The Tanganyika
Graben is part of the
West Branch of the
East African Rift. The
Congolese part of the
Tanganyika Graben is
approximately 16,500
km² (~15,500 km²
offshore and ~1,000 km²
onshore).

Lake Tanganyika is 650 km long, 50 to 80 km wide and having a depth of about 1470 km.

## BID ROUND BLOCKS


11 blocks are offered:
Baraka, Kabimba,
Kakelwa-Babobo,
Kalemie (06), Kibanga
Kisoshi (03), KibiFatuma, Kituku Moliro
(10), Moba, Mpala,
Mulula Lubanga (11) &
Uvira.

### SOURCE ROCKS

Miocene lacustrine argillites, Permo-Triassic Lukuga Formation, Permian charcoals and lacustrine argillites.

#### RESERVOIRS

Tertiary turbidites and Permo-Triassic fluvio-continental sands.



#### PROSPECTIVITY

4 wells are drilled in the Tanganyika Graben and several oil seeps are documented including the spectacular underwater seeps of Cape Kalamba. Important discoveries in the Ugandan part of the Albertine Graben where the Late to Middle Miocene Kisegi Sandstones are considered as the main theme of Exploration.
